HANDBOOK POLICY CHANGE

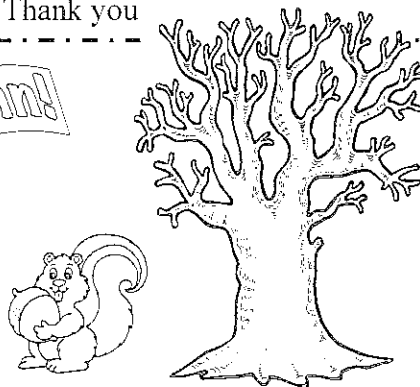

Community Care Licensing and Kinderland Policies require that all parents sign in and out daily with a full legal signature.

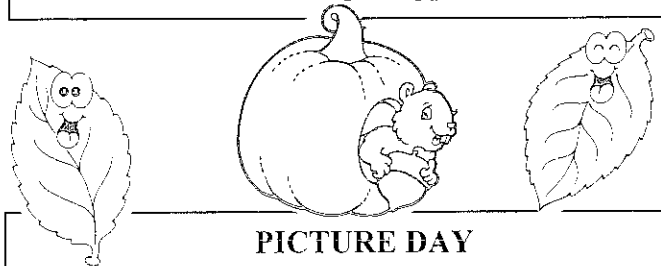
SCHOLASTIC ORDERS

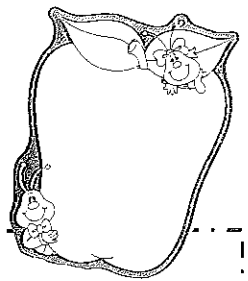


PICTURE DAY

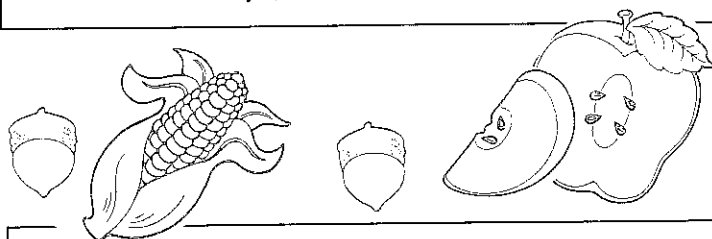

INFANT 3

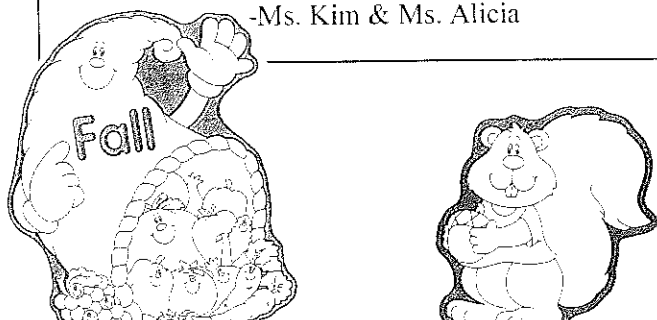

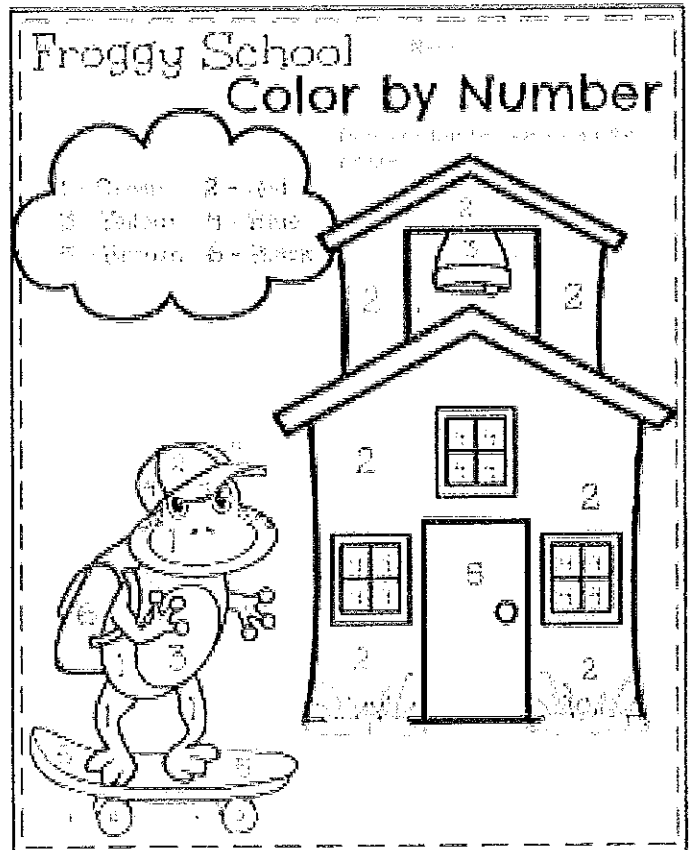
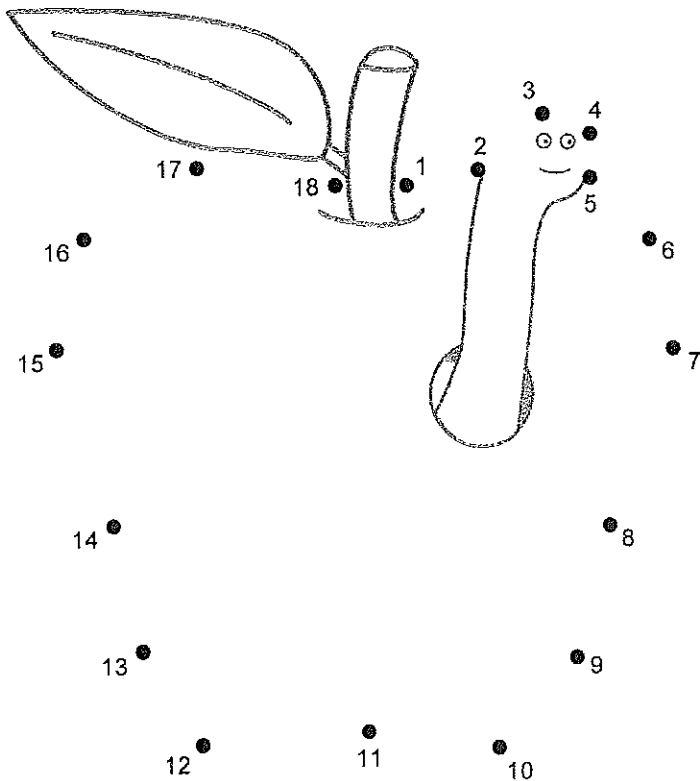
SCHOOL AGE
