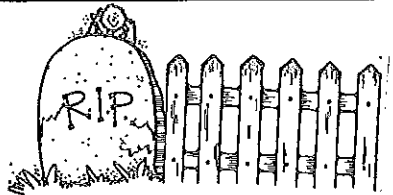

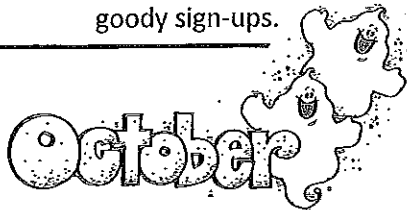


### ANNUAL PAPERWORK UPDATE

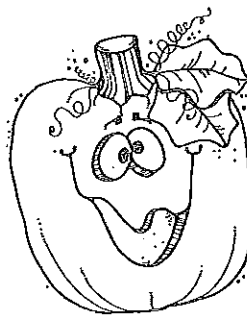
### SICK POLICY

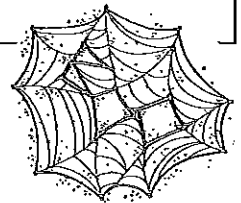

## INFANT I

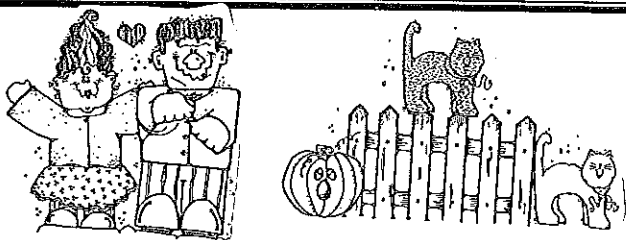

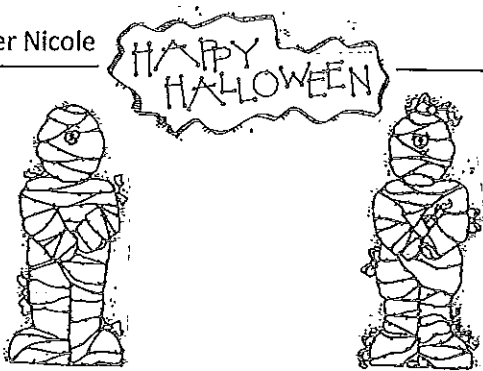

## PRESCHOOL

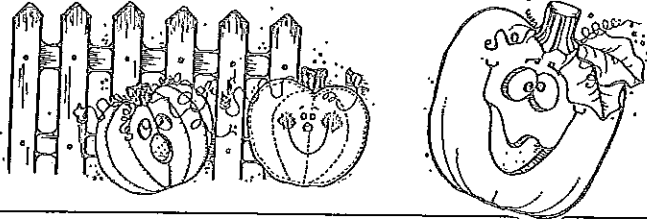

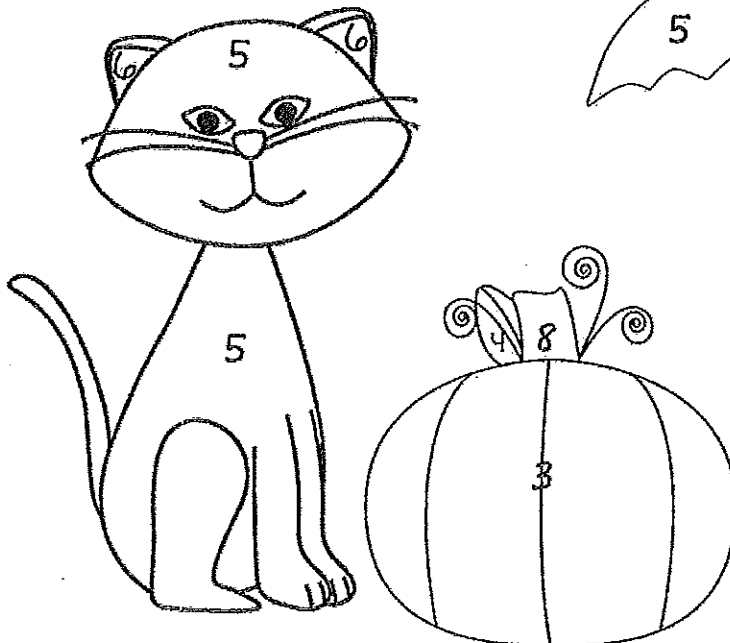
