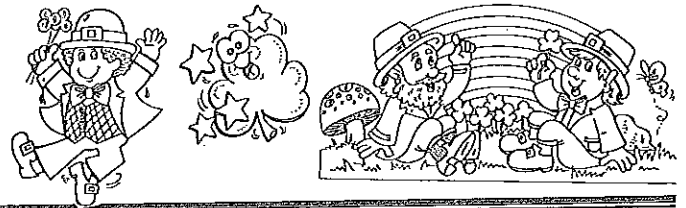


TRIKE-A-THON

SCHOOL AGE

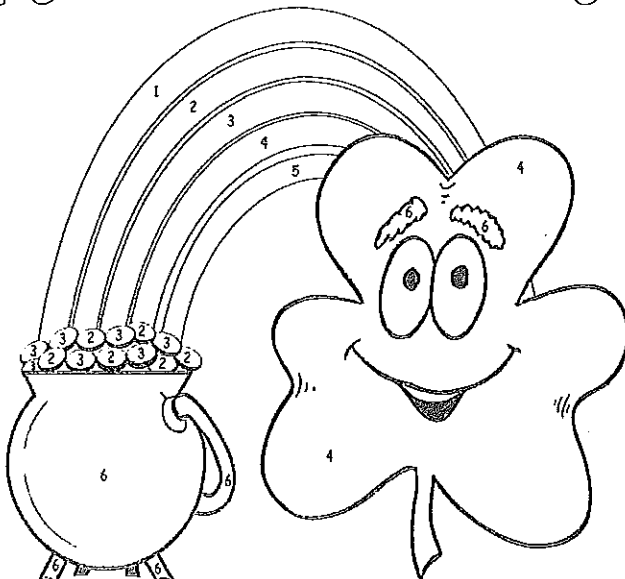
