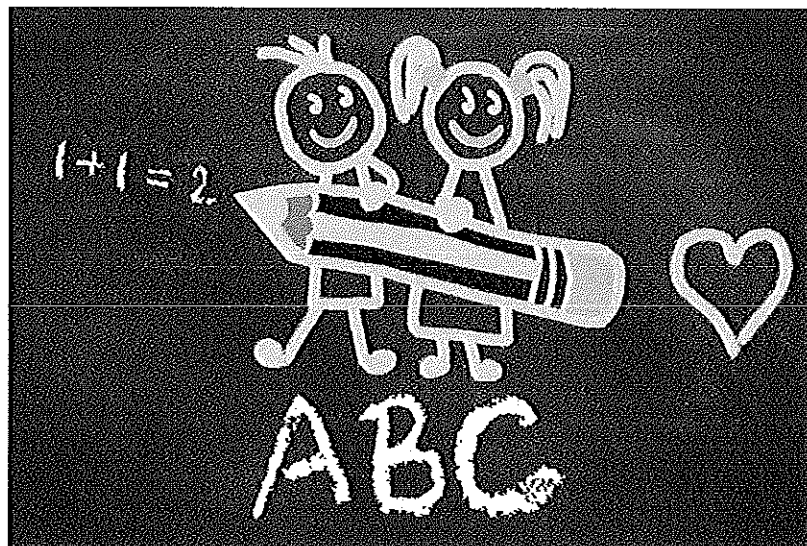

TRANSITION

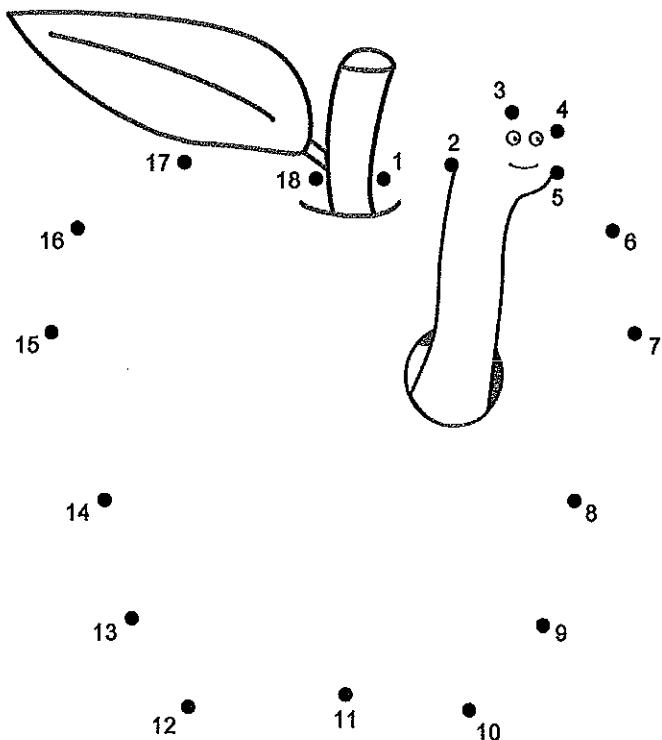
