Helpful note- Please have backs on shoes. Thank you.

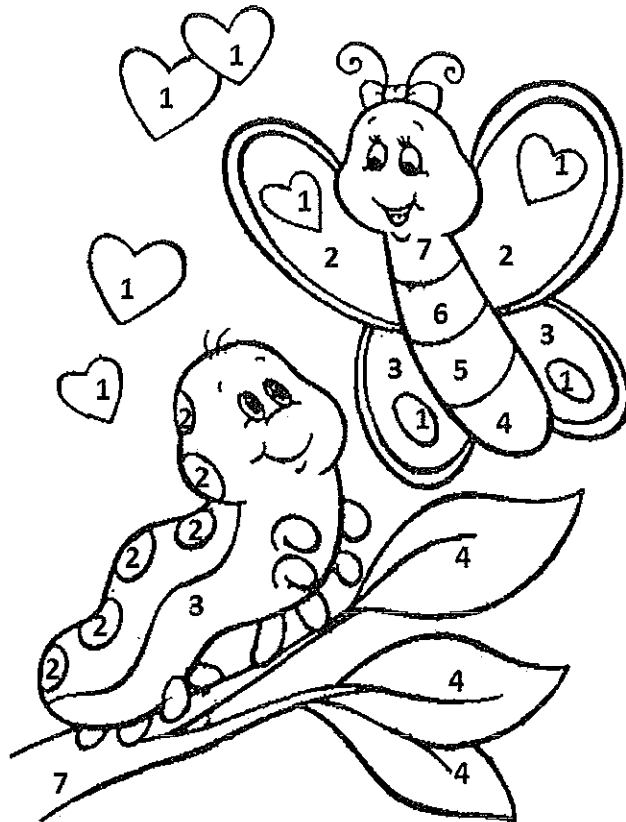

## PRESCHOOL

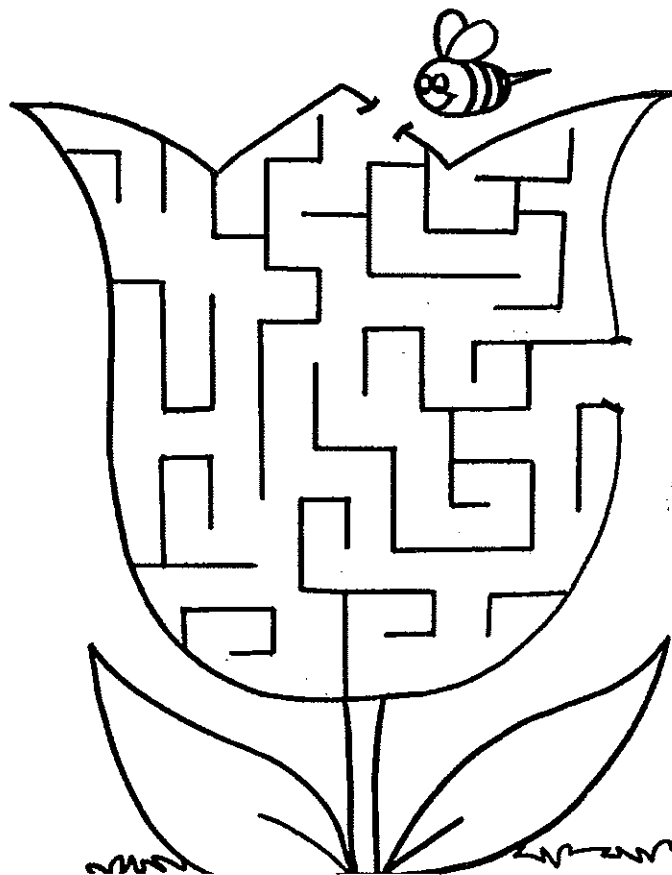
