








BUTTERFLIES


TRANSITION



While there are many colors explored in the book the colors we will be learning about are blue, yellow and green. We will continue our counting 1 to 5. As well as learning the letters S & B.


Please take some time to explore some of the learning in our classroom with your child. When your child sees you are interested in what they are learning. They will be more apt to learn more.




SCHOOL AGE
